SAINT-TROJAN-LES-BAINS

This long town stretches out at the entrance to the island and has all the charm of a late 19th century seaside resort with the elaborate facades of its villas, its forests of maritime pine and a splurge of mimosa in February. One beach follows another all the way from Saint-Trojan to Vert-Bois: first the Grande Plage with water sports, then the Giraudière, the Allasins and the beach at Vert-Bois.
