At Saint-Trojan-les-Bains, at the southern end of the Ile d'Oléron, the P'tit Train de Saint-Trojan will take you on a 12 km round trip to the wild furthest reaches of the Pertuis de Maumusson with its magnificent landscapes of fine sand and pine forests that are inaccessible by road. The P'tit Train de St-Trojan stops at the beaches at Gatseau and Maumusson on the Côte Sauvage. Running since 1963, the P'tit Train de St-Trojan is the ideal way to enjoy sun-filled days on the beach and walks in an unspoilt natural setting. The P'tit Train de St-Trojan also proposes the Train des Saveurs with its selection of local produce (in June and early September), as well as enchanting Sunset Trains (contact us for details of dates).



The station buffet is open from April to September and the Maumusson buffet car in July and August.
